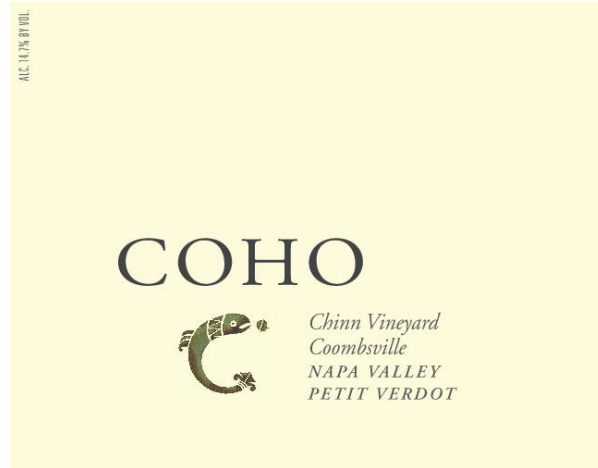


COHO



The Chinn Vineyard in Coombsville has been COHO's exclusive source of Petit Verdot since 2009. The dark fruited flavors of plum and black and blue berries have added distinctive character and richness to many of COHO's wines. Several barrels of Petit Verdot from 2016 were blended with a barreled blend of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon from 2017, and a quarter barrel of Petit Verdot from 2018 to make our first ever Chinn Vineyard Petit Verdot.

Intriguing aromas of violets and sage mixed with the an almost sweet smell of blackberry preserves. Rich and full flavored, the normally intense Petit Verdot fruit has benefitted from the extra aging in French oak barrel that has softened the tannins and added notes of mocha to the wine.
