
COHO



COHO is proud to introduce its new Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon from the exceptional 2013 vintage. The wine is sourced from five small, family-owned vineyards located on Diamond Mountain, Yountville, and Coombsville. Spicy aromatics of licorice and mocha lead to a rich palate of cassis and black cherry flavors. The wine has a lively acidity that will support the flavors for years of exceptional enjoyment. However you won't have to wait as it is already eminently enjoyable. Antonio Galloni wrote in *Vinous* "This is one of the more open-knit, voluptuous wine(s) of the year...Readers looking for immediate gratification will find plenty of that here".

Varietal Composition: 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 24% Merlot, 1% Petit Verdot

Pre-fermentation: Cold-soaked for 3 days at 55 degrees F.

Fermentation: 7 days followed by malo-lactic fermentation in barrels

Aging: 21 months in 100% French oak barrels, 45% new for the vintage
